

2012 Classes – Joyce Webb

March 24 – April 1, 2012 - Spain; a Tangled History of Crusaders and Kings - Experience Spain from the art and architecture of Madrid to Seville's Alcazar, View Christopher Columbus' tomb, and feel the romance of Flamenco dancers. Visit the Rock of Gibraltar and take a day trip to mysterious Tangiers on African's Moroccan coast. Wander Granada's grand Alhambra while learning of Spain's tangled history. 4 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$3,670 includes tuition, airfare, lodging, transportation, all entry fees, a bullfight, and trip to Morocco with guide. \$2,500 without airfare or tuition.

May 26 – June 5, 2012 - Poppies to Paris – From Flanders' Field to Normandy – A Visit to the Sites of World War I & II - Explore trenches and bunkers used during German occupation of Belgium's North Coast. Tour the battlefields in Southern Belgium's Flanders Field. Travel to Normandy for an in-depth view of WW II's beaches, cemeteries and other war sites. Continue on to Paris for a visit to one of the world's best WW I & II's museums. Learn how Germany occupation affected Paris and the rest of France. 4 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$3,970 - includes tuition, airfare, tours, ground transportation, hotels, and museum passes to major museums. \$2,300 without airfare or tuition.

June 5 -17, 2012 - Italy Revealed: Exploring the Ancient Land of the Romans - Travel from Roman temples to medieval churches and from the ruins of Pompeii to Vatican City's treasure trove. Walk through the Roman Forum and sleep in the city of Orvieto. Experience Florence, the artistic capital of the world; hike along Le Cinque Terra, the sun-drenched Italian Riviera; marvel at the Leaning Tower of Pisa; and absorb Venice, the most romantic city in the world. 5 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$4,210 - includes airfare, tuition, all tours, ground transportation, lodging, and entry fees to major museums. \$2,500 without airfare for tuition.

June 17-25, 2012 – Museums of Paris - Visit the Louvre, Orsay, Rodin, and Picasso Museums plus tour Versailles. Climb Notre-Dame, cruise the Seine, zip up the Eiffel Tower, and saunter down the Avenue des Champs Elysees to the Arc de Triomphe. Join us and help capture the romance and joie de vivre that Paris exudes. 4 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$3470 – Class cost includes airfare, tuition, lodging, ground transportation, museum passes and tours. \$2,000 without airfare or tuition.

June 25-July 3, 2012 - Ireland: Haunted by History, Rich in Legends -Experience the unpretentious simplicity of Ireland and the unhurried pace of its people. Tour the Southwestern Emerald Isle from castles to peat bogs, explore the famous Aran Islands to the Burrens to the Gaelic speaking Dingle Peninsula, kiss the Blarney Stone, and climb the Rock of Cashel. 4 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$2,670- Class cost includes tuition, airfare, ground transportation, entry fees, and all lodging with full Irish breakfast each day. \$1,500 without airfare or tuition.

July 2-10, 2012 – Ireland II – Haunted by History, Dawning of a New Day

Tour Dublin, Belfast, and the east coast of Ireland. Discover the past as you gaze upon the Book of Kells, explore the tomb of Newgrange, and wander through the 6th century monastery of Glendolough. Visit Trim Castle and explore the volcanic columns of the Giant's Causeway. The past and present become blended into another Irish adventure. 4 hours credit available - **Cost:** \$2,770. Class cost includes tuition, airfare, ground transportation, entry fees, and all lodging with full Irish breakfast each day. \$1,600 without airfare for tuition.

July 18 -28, 2012 – Green River Trip – Majestic Journey from Glaciers to Gorges - Discover river headwater, geysers, mud pots, and mountains while exploring Yellowstone and the Grand Tetons. Follow the Green River from its mother snowfields in the Wind river Range through the beautiful Flaming Gorge and into the sandstone cliffs of Dinosaur National Monument. Whitewater raft and canoe through convoluted canyons and gaze upon dinosaur bones and Fremont Rock Art while conducting authentic environmental research. 5 hours credit available – **Cost:** \$1,810 with credit - \$1,600 without credit.
